

General Rules & Guidelines for CSI Competition

Monday

Don't forget to attend CSI Workshops!

Monday Night Opening Banquet will be a Crime Scene Brief

Bring note taking materials

Tuesday

At Competition

NO PPE requirements, not a hazmat issue - standard police/detective crime response scene

Handle like a crime scene, standard criminal/police investigation processes are expected.

Think: Criminal Investigation 101, Criminal Procedure 101, Criminal Law 101, Legal Issues 101

Teams of 3 will need to show up 15 minutes early to staging area

Bring laptop for report room and 1 phone for taking photos. Generate a rough sketch of crime scene.

Note taking materials will be provided.

Only one (1) competitor on the team can take photos inside the room

Teams will have a total of 20 minutes to work the crime scene. Teams can ask the proctor questions while in the CSI room.

They may or may not get an answer from the proctor.

Teams can open and close things but should keep the room as close to as it is set as possible, like any other TRUE crime scene.

Report Room

Teams can have 3 follow up questions during report writing.

You will have a total of 45 minutes to complete a sketch and report.

Wednesday

Crime Scene Explanation

Top 5 Crime Scene Teams will be presented a certificate by our special guest at the Speaker Series.

Medals and Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be handed out at Award Banquet.
